Professor Fernando Magro's degree in Medicine was awarded by Faculty of Medicine of Porto University (FMUP) in 1992 and he became a specialist in Gastroenterology in 1998. In 2007, he earned a doctorate degree in Pharmacology, became a specialist in Clinical Pharmacology by 2017 and in 2018 earned his tenure in "Experimental and Clinical Pharmacology and Toxicology" at FMUP.

Professor Fernando Magro is a consultant in Gastroenterology and Director of the Clinical Pharmacology Unit, at the São João University Hospital in Porto, Portugal.

He's a founder, board member, and research head of the Portuguese IBD Study Group (GEDII).

Internationally, he is the current President of the European Crohn's and Colitis Organization (ECCO). He also serves as a member of the International Organization for the Study of Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IOIBD).
